Common Covenant Violations

The following violations are becoming more and more frequent throughout Legacy Park. Please ensure that your home is free of these violations to avoid letters and fines. Any questions can be directed to the HOA office at 770-919-2556. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Garbage Cans & Recycling Bins - Garbage Cans and Recycling Bins must be stored in a location not visible from the street. They may be placed curbside the evening before pick-up and must be returned to a proper storage area the evening following pick-up.

Mail Boxes, Posts & Number Plates - All mailboxes must be properly maintained. Missing or broken parts should be replaced. Mailboxes and posts that are faded and/or rusting should be painted. Mailboxes should be painted black with the appropriate silver or gold accents. For your convenience, the HOA has a painter that will come and paint your mailbox for \$20.00. Simply drop off a check at the HOA office and your name will be added to the list.

Flower Beds - All flower beds must be maintained at all times. Regular weeding and edging is required. Ground cover such as pine straw or mulch must be in good condition and provide complete coverage of the beds. Dying or dead plant material should be removed.

Lawn - Regular and routine maintenance of the front and side lawn of your home is required. This includes mowing and edging along the curb, driveway, and flower beds. Regular treatment for weeds and removal of weeds is also required.

Stream Bank Restoration Project

Legacy Park, in conjunction with the City of Kennesaw, will soon undertake the restoration of four areas along the banks of Proctor Creek which runs through the heart of our park and green space. With input and persistence from Mark Mathews, a Legacy Park resident and City Councilman, the City of Kennesaw set aside \$25,000 of grant funds to enable us to restore and replenish areas of erosion along Proctor Creek. This project will be a joint effort, both financially and physically, between Legacy Park and the City of Kennesaw. It will enable the city to train and utilize some of their maintenance and environmental personnel on the many tasks involved with such a project while helping Legacy Park receive much needed repairs to the stream banks at a reduced cost. The project will also give us the opportunity to work hand-in-hand in a friendly, peaceful situation with our city government. It is a very important project in that it shows what can happen when private and government entities work together to solve issues that affect all of us.

Termites in Legacy Park

Recently the number of homes in Legacy Park infested with termites has increased. Keep an eye out for signs of infestation, and take these steps to reduce the risk of termites.

Signs of Infestation

The following are some of the signs of termite infestation:

- Pencil-wide mud tubes on the foundation walls.
- Winged "swarmer" termites, or their shed wings, on window sills and along the edges of floors.
- Wood hollowed out along the grain, lined with bits of mud or soil.

Detecting hidden termite infestation requires a trained eye. Most pest control companies will inspect your home free of charge and alert the homeowner to any conditions they uncover which are conducive to termite infestation.

Ways to Deter Termites

- Eliminate wood to ground contact. Many termite infestations result from wood being in direct contact with the soil. Earth-to-wood contact provides termites an easy access to food, moisture and shelter, as well as direct, hidden entry into the home. Termites will even infest pressure treated wood through cracks and split ends.
- Don't let moisture accumulate near the foundation. Termites must have moisture to survive and are likely to "zero" in on a home if the soil next to it is consistently moist. Moisture will also break down any chemical barrier that might be protecting the home. Leaky faucets, moisture around doors and windows and air conditioning units should be repaired, and if necessary, ground near the foundation should be re-graded to increase drainage.
- Never store firewood, lumber or other wood debris against the foundation. These items all have cellulose that attract termites and provide a source of food.
- Use mulch sparingly. Many people use landscape mulch for its aesthetic and plant health benefits. Excessive or improper

usage, however, can contribute to termite problems.

- Consider having the structure treated by a professional pest control company. Homes have many natural openings through which termites can enter undetected. While the above measures will help make the home less attractive to termites, the best protection is to install a chemical barrier around the home.

Preventively treating a home for termites is a reasonable investment, especially if the home has no prior history of treatment. It is very difficult to sell a home without a current termite bond. Most home buyers are very aware of the termite threat here in the southeast.
