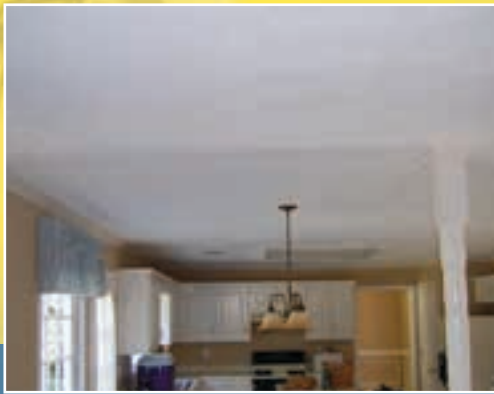

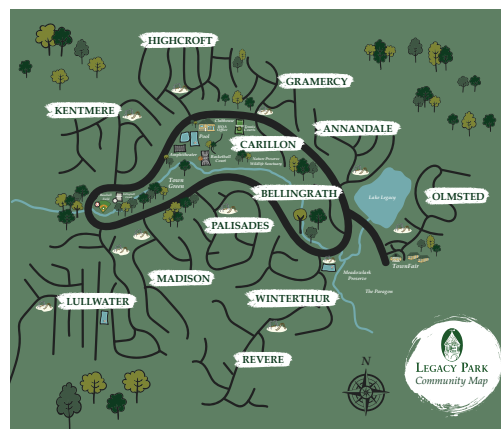

Hello Summer, Hello Pool Season!

Summer has officially arrived in Legacy Park!

With pool season underway and the school year coming to a close, we hope everyone takes time to relax, connect with neighbors, and enjoy all the wonderful amenities our community has to offer.

A special congratulations goes out to the Legacy Park Class of 2026! We were proud to celebrate 115 graduating seniors with congratulatory signs lining the boulevard. What an exciting milestone for these students and their families!

SUMMER REMINDERS FOR ENJOYING LEGACY PARK

To help keep our amenities safe, enjoyable, and accessible for everyone, please keep these reminders in mind:

- Always carry your Legacy Park ID with the current 2026 sticker when using any common area amenities.
- Amenities are monitored regularly. Violations such as unauthorized access or propping gates open may result in suspension of amenity privileges.
- Dogs must remain leashed at all times while on common property.
- The Fitness Center is for residents only—guests are not permitted, and each resident must use their own ID for entry.
- Have questions about community rules or policies? Please contact the HOA office directly. While community Facebook groups

can be helpful for neighbor discussions, they are not official sources for HOA information.

Thank you for helping us maintain a safe, respectful, and welcoming environment throughout the community.

KEEPING LEGACY PARK BEAUTIFUL

Our landscaping team at Gibson has been hard at work keeping Legacy Park looking its best despite the rainy spring weather and rapid weed growth that comes with it.

Summer flowers were planted in mid-April, and Deer Out treatments continue to be used to help protect new plantings from deer activity. The frequent rain has made this an ongoing challenge, but efforts are continuing throughout the community.

Looking ahead, a fresh application of pine straw is scheduled for late June to help refresh and enhance our landscaping areas for the summer season.

POOL SEASON IS HERE!

All pools officially opened on May 2, and both the Main Pool and Lullwater Pool now have lifeguard coverage seven days a week. Be sure to check the pool schedule included in this newsletter for specific guard hours at each location.

We are continuing the pool safety policy introduced last year regarding lifeguard breaks. During the lifeguard's 10-minute safety break each hour, all swimmers must exit the pool—no exceptions. Signs are posted at both guarded pools to help communicate and enforce this policy.

In the past, some swimmers remained in the water during breaks under unguarded pool guidelines. However, to maintain consistency, fairness, and the highest level of safety, Legacy Park—along with many large HOA communities—is following current best practices: no swimming is permitted while lifeguards are off duty, regardless of age.

These short breaks are a great time to reapply sunscreen, grab water, and take a quick rest before getting back in the pool.

Thank you for your cooperation and for helping us keep our pools safe and enjoyable for everyone this summer!

2026 PROJECTS AND COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS

In addition to ongoing maintenance and beautification efforts, several important projects are underway throughout the community:

2025 Financial Audit

The Association's 2025 financial audit is currently in progress. Once completed, the audit will be submitted to the Board for review and approval before becoming part of the Association's official records.

Main Pool Deck Repairs

Repairs to the Main Pool deck were completed following winter damage. Although originally planned for next year, the Board determined it was important to accelerate the project timeline to ensure the area was ready for pool season. We appreciate Original 7 for accommodating the revised schedule and completing the work before opening day.



Special thank you to the volunteers that came out Sunday morning to put the Pool Furniture back in place.



Playground Improvements

Repairs at the Madison Playground have been completed, and the playground has now been fully stained and sealed to match the refreshed appearance of the other community playgrounds updated this year.



Lullwater Pool Landscape Refresh

Trees at the Lullwater Pool were removed due to roots causing damage and lifting sections of concrete. The stumps have been ground, and landscaping improvements are currently underway in the area.



Court Conversion Project

At the time this newsletter was submitted, the tennis court conversion project was still in progress but is expected to be completed by publication. This project converts two existing tennis courts into eight dedicated pickleball courts to better accommodate the growing interest in pickleball within the community.

Along with the new court setup, enhancements are being made to the reservation system so residents can easily identify and reserve either tennis or pickleball courts online.

Additional amenities and landscaping improvements around the courts, including possible seating and shade features, will be evaluated following construction completion.



Tennis Court Resurfacing

Tennis Courts 1 and 2 (formerly Courts 7 and 8 prior to renumbering) have been resurfaced and are ready for play.

Sign Replacement Project Complete

New signposts for Revere and Winterthur have now been installed, officially completing the neighborhood-wide mandatory sign replacement project.

Lake Legacy Monitoring

Aquascape Environmental continues to perform monthly inspections of Lake Legacy. These inspections include monitoring wildlife activity, aquatic vegetation, litter conditions, and operation of both the primary and emergency spillways.

These projects reflect the Association’s continued commitment to maintaining and enhancing the Legacy Park community for all residents to enjoy.

Revere Landscape Refresh

The landscaping at the Revere entrance also received a refresh this season. Over time, several plants and shrubs in the area had become aged or were no longer thriving, making replacement necessary. Updated plantings and landscape improvements were installed to enhance the overall appearance of the entrance and maintain the welcoming look of the neighborhood.

IMPORTANT POOL SAFETY REMINDER

Outside of designated lifeguard hours, swimming is strictly at your own risk (SAYOR).

- Residents must be 16 or older to swim without supervision.

- Residents under 16 must be accompanied by someone 16 or older.

A FRIENDLY REMINDER FOR OUR DOG-LOVING RESIDENTS

Do you have a dog that enjoys walking through Legacy Park? We love seeing our furry friends out and about, but we want to remind all pet owners of a few important rules to help keep our community safe and clean.

LEASH LAWS & RULES

It is both a Legacy Park Rules & Regulations violation and a City of Kennesaw ordinance for animals to be off-leash or out of their owner's immediate control. All pets must be on a leash no longer than six feet and under the control of someone capable of managing them.

RESTRICTED AREAS

Pets are not permitted in any fenced community areas, including the ballfield, tennis courts, pool areas, and playgrounds.

CLEAN-UP IS A MUST

Being a responsible pet owner means cleaning up after your pet. Please pick up and properly dispose of pet waste. Failure to comply may result in suspension of amenity privileges.

Convenient waste stations and trash receptacles are located throughout Legacy Park to assist you.

Any changes to your home or yard (front or back) must be approved via the ARC form in the Resident Center. This includes:

- New paint colors
- Landscaping updates
- Additions or removals (e.g., sheds, patios, trees)

Download the form and instructions from the Buildium portal before starting any work.

MODERNIZING WITH CARE

As a 30-year-old community, we aim to stay current while honoring our homes' original architecture. New styles and color palettes may be considered if they remain in harmony with existing design. All exterior updates must be pre-approved.

MAINTENANCE IN LEGACY PARK

STREET & INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE IN LEGACY PARK

Street maintenance within Legacy Park is managed by the City of Kennesaw Public Works. If you notice potholes, damaged roadway areas, downed street signs, or other street-related concerns, please report them directly through the City's Public Works reporting page: https://www.kennesaw-ga.gov/public-works/?utm_source=chatgpt.com

The HOA is also happy to assist with reporting outages if you provide the street light pole number. However, because some homeowners have previously requested adjustments to lighting levels near their homes, we encourage residents to work directly with Georgia Power whenever possible so that any follow-up communication remains between the homeowner and the utility provider.

IMPORTANT REMINDER LEASING RULES IN LEGACY PARK

Are you considering leasing your basement or individual rooms within your home? Please be aware that this is a violation of the Legacy Park Covenants.

As outlined in the Legacy Park Declaration, leasing is defined as the “regular, exclusive occupancy of a Unit by any person other than the Owner, for which the Owner receives any consideration or benefit, including but not limited to a fee, service, gratuity, or emolument.” Importantly, leasing refers to the entire Unit—not a portion of it. For a lease to be considered compliant, the whole Unit must be leased, not just a room or basement.

Renting out a part of your property—such as a basement or individual rooms—is not recognized as permissible leasing under the Declaration. Instead, such activity may be considered the operation of a business or trade, which is prohibited under Paragraph 2(r) of the Initial Use Restrictions. “Any business, trade or similar activity, except that an Owner or occupant residing in a Unit may conduct business activities within the Unit so long as: (i) the existence or operation of the business activity is not apparent or detectable by sight, sound, or smell from outside the Unit; (ii) the business activity conforms to all zoning requirements for the Properties; (iii) the business activity does not involve regular visitation of the Unit by clients, customers, suppliers..... and (iv) the business activity is consistent with the residential character of the Properties and does not constitute a nuisance, or a hazardous or offensive use, or threaten the security or safety of other residents of the Properties, as may be determined in the sole discretion of the Board.”

Modification Application Process

- Homeowners can submit a new Architectural Request (Modification Application), upload the relevant forms and supporting documents, and the HOA team can communicate important status updates or follow up questions - all in the Resident Center. No more back and forth emails and phone calls and no need for external systems and paperwork.
- When a decision is reached, homeowners will be notified immediately.
- The approval/denial and application will remain on the homeowner account for future reference and be tied to your property.

How to Create an Architectural Request through Buildium

1. Log in to the Resident Center through a browser.
2. From the Resident Center menu, select Architectural Requests.
3. On the Architectural Requests page, the homeowner can view open **Projects**, along with the date of the request, current status, and the decision reached (once completed).
4. To create a new request, click **Create an Architectural Request**.
5. The homeowner can upload up to 10 files, each must be 15MB or less in size. Be sure the ARC Modification form is one of your documents.
6. Homeowner gives a **Name to the project**.
7. When ready, click **Submit request**.
8. After submitting the request, the homeowner can provide additional updated or upload new documents by tying in the Updates text box and/or clicking the Upload button to add more files, and then click Send.

While we encourage everyone to utilize this portal going forward, we realize this may not be feasible for all. Please work with the HOA office on requests if you are not able to upload into the portal.

Instructions

Please complete the Modification Form and upload it to your request. Modification requests are often denied due to a lack of information. Please check the Modification Application to confirm that all information is included in your specific request. Modification Form

Items to confirm you have submitted:

- Form with complete description.
- Pictures – Project location (House/windows/yard/etc.), sample pictures (windows, additions, etc.) and neighboring houses on each side.
- Paint chips/color samples.
- Drawings – Landscaping (placement with names), project location with measurements, etc.
- Plat of your property.

The information you provided is exactly what will be submitted to the ARC. If documentation is missing or incorrect, your modification request will be denied and you will need to resubmit the following month with the required information.

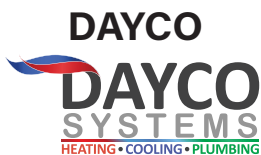

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q Where is the HOA administrative office?

A It is located at ground level of the Legacy Park Clubhouse.

Q When does the Board of Directors meet?

A On the 4th Tuesday of each month in the evening at the Clubhouse. All homeowners are welcome to attend.

Q How do I obtain an amenity ID card and current stickers?

A Amenity tag stickers are distributed, by mail, in the spring of each year, if dues are paid in full. The ID card with a current sticker allows homeowners access to all of Legacy Park's common area and amenities. To get the ID card, please complete the form on our website under the Resident tab prior to stopping by the HOA office.

Q How many guests can I have?

A Up to (2) guests are allowed per resident over the age of 18 for use of the Trails, Town Green, Playgrounds, Amphitheater, Bandstand and Baseball Field, Swimming Pools, Tennis Courts, Volleyball Court and Basketball Court.

Unaccompanied children between the ages of 12 and 18 are allowed only one (1) guest while on LP property and when using the amenities.

Unaccompanied children between 12 and 15 cannot have a guest younger than themselves.

Guests are considered to be non-LP residents. LP residents that have had their privileges revoked cannot come as a guest of another resident.

A LP resident must accompany guests while on the common properties or while using any of the amenities. Long term guest (persons visiting for more than two weeks) may obtain a guest pass from the HOA office.

Q How do I reserve an amenity for a private event?

A Amenity Reservation forms are available on our website.

Clubhouse – FAQ/Amenities/Clubhouse

Amphitheater/Bandstand/Town Green/Baseball – FAQ/Amenities/Amenity Reservation Form

Q Where do I get a copy of the Design Standards and Community Rules & Regulations?

A Your Welcome Packet includes them! To assure you have the most updated version, please visit Legacy Park's website at www.legacypark.org under FAQ.



Q Who is responsible for upholding the Design Standards and Covenants?

A Every homeowner is expected to maintain his or her property in a manner consistent with all applicable covenants. Refer to the Declaration of Covenants: Articles IV, V and XI. It is required that a modification application be approved by the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) before any changes are made to the exterior of your home, i.e. landscaping, painting, etc. Refer to Design Standards for additional information and restrictions. All violations of the Covenants or Design Standards may be assessed penalties.

Q What modifications do I need to get approval for?

A Approval is needed for anything you do on the exterior of your home and property, front and back. This includes all landscaping, paint (even if painting the same color), new door, new roof, new windows, fence, patio, trampoline, etc. If you are not sure if it needs approval, please contact the HOA office.

Q When are Homeowner Assessments due?

A They are due annually by January 1st. An invoice will be sent prior to this date; however, as stated in our covenants, not receiving an invoice is not a valid reason for not paying your assessments. Refer to Declaration of Covenants-Article X. A 10% late fee will apply for payment received after January 31st and interest will accrue on the assessment with a late charge at an annual rate of 7%.

Q What happens if I don't pay my Homeowners Assessments?

A As mentioned above, there will be a 10% late fee and interest will accrue on the assessment with a late charge at an annual rate of 7%. Also, suspension of all Owners' rights to access or use any of the Legacy Park common areas, amenities and any Legacy Park supported events will occur. The HOA also reserves the right to take legal action, including but not limited to, liens against the property.

Q Who is responsible for what?

A Each week the HOA office receives many calls wanting to know if the HOA is responsible for a specific area. Here is a brief rundown of some of the more common questions.

Amenity and Common Areas: These areas are owned and maintained by the Legacy Park HOA. The dues paid by each homeowner contribute to the upkeep of these areas: The main Legacy Park entrance, the area along Legacy Park Boulevard, Lake Legacy, the area along Legacy Park Circle, the neighborhood entrances and monuments, Town Green, neighborhood playgrounds, Town Club, Pools, Pump Houses, Amphitheater, Tennis Courts, Basketball Court, Baseball field, Walking Trails, Bridges, Picnic Grove and the Bandstand. To report a problem in one of these areas contact the HOA office.

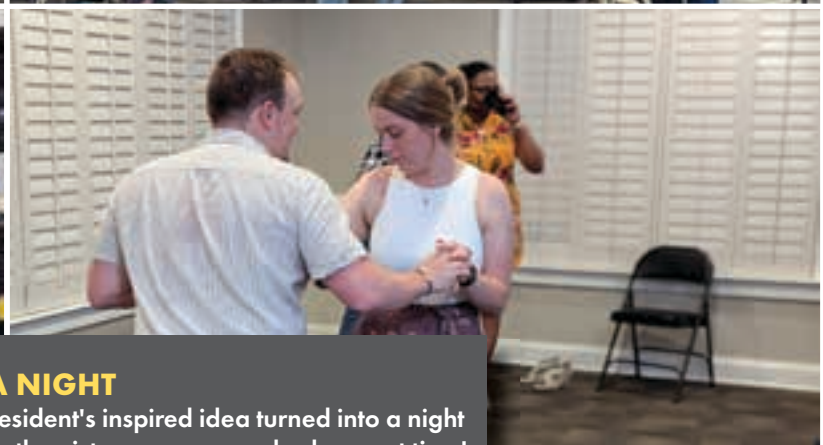
Streets & Sidewalks: All of the streets within Legacy Park are owned and maintained by the City of Kennesaw. The KPD has the right to ticket and/or tow any car illegally parked on the street or sidewalk. The non-emergency number for the KPD is 770-422-2505.

Streetlights: The ornamental streetlights and the lights at the common areas are maintained by the HOA. To report an outage, contact the HOA (if the pole is numbered, please provide this information). The "cobra head" streetlights are owned and maintained by Georgia Power or Cobb EMC depending on who provides the power in the area. To report a light problem, contact GA Power at 888-655-5888 or Cobb EMC at 770-249-2100 or visit their websites and report an outdoor lighting issue.

Trees along neighborhood streets: The homeowner is the owner of the trees that are planted in the neighborhoods between the street and the sidewalk. It is the responsibility of the individual homeowner to prune these trees on a regular basis. The city recommends that you remove any branches growing at a height lower than 6 feet.

Power Lines: Georgia Power owns the high voltage power lines that run through Legacy Park. Legacy Park owns the property and Georgia Power has an easement. Both the HOA and Georgia Power take care of cutting the grass and maintaining the land that the lines are located on. If there is an issue, contact the HOA Office.

Storm Water Drainage Areas: These areas that run between neighborhoods and at the back of homeowner's lots are generally owned by the individual homeowner. Each homeowner should refer to the plat of their property for further clarification. However, if a major drainage problem exists with the drain itself the homeowner should contact the HOA office and we can direct you to the proper authorities to address the issue (Cobb County Water or the City of Kennesaw).

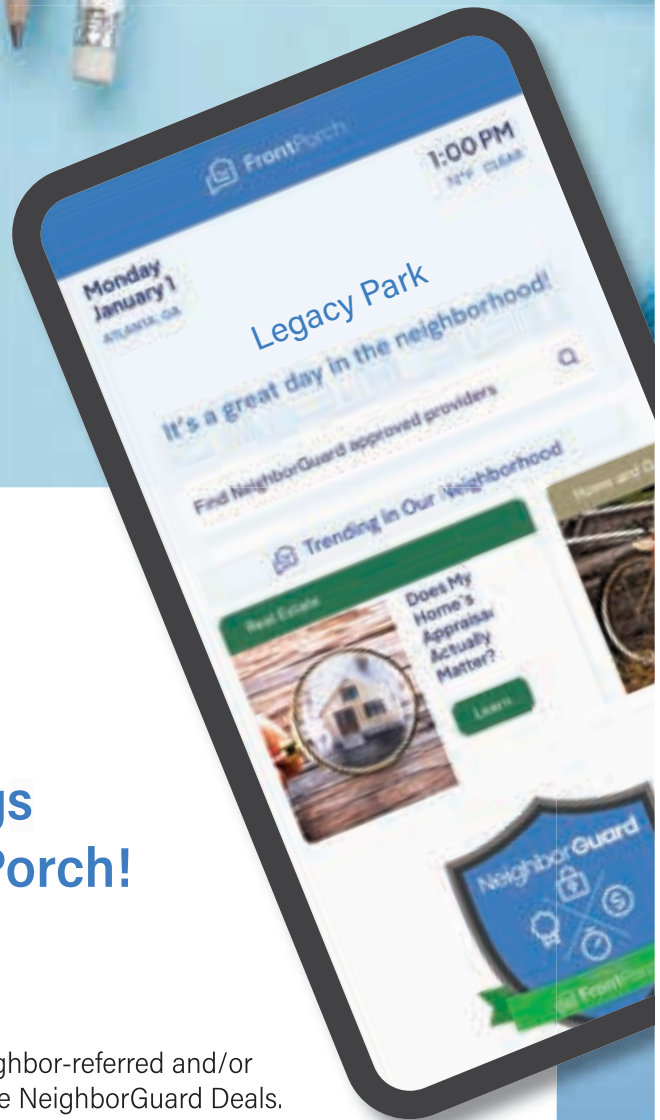

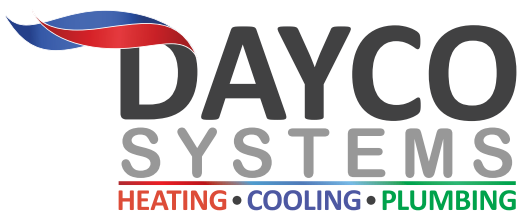
